

Please note that these prices are intended as an approximate guide to what the actual repair cost will be for any particular repair

## SET UP

\* Includes: supply (except for basses) and install new strings • adjust truss rod • check for loose frets and warped fretboard • tighten/lube tuning machines • check, adjust nut slots • adjust action at saddle and nut via sanding and/or shims

## CRACK REPAIRS

| Glue and cleat every inch | \$25 per inch     |
| Splinted as well          | Add \$35 per inch |
| Finish repairs            | Add \$75 and up   |

## BODY (for acoustic guitar)

| Reglue loose or broken brace                        | \$60-80   |
| Pickguard (remove and reglue)                       | \$60-80   |
| Remove, refit and reglue existing bridge            | \$120     |
| Remove and replace bridge (guitar)                  |           |
| • With after market rosewood bridge                 | \$175     |
| • With custom bridge                                | \$225-300 |
| Repair small cracks in bridge                       | \$40      |
| Mill bridge thinner (plus saddle and slot work)     | \$80      |
| Rerouting saddle slot for wider/deeper saddle       | \$50      |
| Raise or lower bridge saddle                        |           |
| • via movable cartridge                             | \$25      |
| • via sanding or shim                               | \$35      |
| Bridgeplate repair, rosewood overlay & fit new pins | \$100     |

## NUT & SADDLE WORK

| • Partially compensated narrow bone       | \$60      |
| • Fully compensated (faceted wide saddle) | \$100-150 |
| New Custom Bone Nut                       |           |
| • 6-string guitar                         | \$60      |
| • 12-string guitar                        | \$120     |
| • Mandolin                                | \$80      |
| • Ukulele, Banjo                          | \$40      |
| • Bass guitar (4, 5 or 6-string)          | \$55-75   |

## FRET & NECK WORK

| Complete fret dressing  |                  |
| • Includes: leveling, recrowning and polishing  | \$150-175        |
| • Glue in loose frets before dressing   | \$5 per fret     |
| • (12-string guitars, 5, 6 and 8-string basses)   | Add \$25-50      |
| Complete refret **  |                  |
| <i>** Includes: removing old frets, light sanding of the fingerboard, installing new frets and a complete fret dressing</i> |                  |
| • On unbound neck   | \$300            |
| • On plastic and hardwood bound neck  | Add \$40         |
| • Lacquered maple fretboard   | Add \$200        |
| • Plane flat badly worn or humped fretboard   | Add \$40-80      |
| • Change radius of fretboard  | Add \$60-120     |
| Broken neck or head   | \$80 and up      |
| • Repair finish to same   | Add \$125 and up |
| Neck reset  |                  |
| • Martin style  | \$350            |
| • Gibson style  | \$450            |
| • Tongue shim if required ***   | \$75             |

\*\*\* Note that with a neck reset: it is often necessary, to add a tongue shim, do a complete refret, replace the nut, and/or bridge saddle, at the same time.
